2. Pursuant to KRS 65.8835(1) and Section 11-4(m)(1) of the Code, the City of Nicholasville shall possess a lien on the Property for the civil fine set forth in the Citation and for all charges and fees incurred by the City of Nicholasville in connection with the enforcement of the Code, including abatement costs, which lien shall bear interest at the rate of 12% per annum until fully satisfied and may be enforced by judicial proceedings, including an action to foreclose. 3. Pursuant to KRS 65.835 and Section 11-4(m)(4) of the Code, the City of Nicholasville may bring a civil action against the Owner(s) and shall have the same remedies as provided for the recovery of a debt.

4. Pursuant to KRS 65.8836(3) and Section 11-4(o) of the Code, a lien holder of record may, within forty-five (45) days from the date of this Notice, correct the violation(s) if not already abated, and elect to pay all civil fines assessed for the violation(s) and all charges and fees incurred by the City of Nicholasville in connection with the enforcement of the ordinance, including abatement costs. If the City's lien is fully satisfied prior to the expiration of the forty-five (45) day period, the City of Nicholasville shall release its lien within fifteen (15) days of satisfaction.
